- V. The proposals of the various Departments as per meeting agenda and decisions taken/advice of the Technical Evaluation Committee are described below:

1. Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board (DSSSB)

The proposal of DSSSB regarding extension of 04 technical manpower hired through NICS I under OARS project of DSSSB for a period of another 12 months w.e.f. 05/01/2024, received with the recommendation of the Chairman, DSSSB was placed before TEC meeting held on 12/03/2024.

TEC discussed the proposal of DSSSB as per details given in the TEC agenda no 1 as mentioned in attached Annexure-I and based on deliberations and justification given in the proposal, TEC concurred the proposal for extension of 04 technical manpower for 12 months w.e.f 05/01/2024. Further, TEC advised that the department may freeze their existing requirements so that the technical manpower in place shall undertake the development of OARS portal in New Technology at the earliest.

2. Department of Food & Supplies and Consumer Affairs




VI. Further TEC recommended as follows:







Proposal of DSSSB is for seeking approval of TEC for extension of 04 technical manpower hired through NICSI under OARS project of DSSSB for a period of another 12 months w.e.f. 05/01/2024. The proposal has been received with the recommendations of the Chairman, DSSSB. DSSSB has informed the following: -

- i. Online Application Registration System (OARS) has been implemented in the year 2013, developed by NIC, Delhi State Unit which have various online modules related to conduct examinations. Over the period of time advancements of several modifications, new provisions and facilities have also been developed and incorporated in the OARS portal.
- ii. Recently DSSSB has conceptualised to conduct the "Combined Examinations" for similar posts of various user departments through the new "Combined Examination Module" in OARS, which is under development stage. The main purpose of the combined examinations is to invite single online application in OARS from aspiring applicants for similar types of posts from departments of GNCT of Delhi. This new exercise of combined examinations may save the time and effort of all the resources presently being utilised to conduct the various examinations.
- iii. 04 technical manpower were hired from NICSI for the period 05/01/2023 to 04/01/2024 after obtaining approval of IT and Finance Department for the development, customisation and maintenance of the complete OARS Project of DSSSB.
- iv. NICSI has provided PI dated 08/01/2024 for 04 technical manpower as per following description:

The total expenditure for hiring these 04 technical manpower for 01 years is 49,31,261/-.

The proposal of the DSSSB has been examined and following is observed:

1. The term of existing hired 04 technical manpower has expired on 04-01-2024.
- ii. The hired manpower from NICSI is not engaged against vacant post.
- iii. The retention of existing manpower is essential for continuity of the ongoing ORS project.
- iv. DSSSB has sought extension of these 04 technical manpower (2 level 7/Tier-2, 1 Level 8/Tier-2, 1 Level 9/Tier-2 and all with minimum work experience of 05 years) for another 12 months i.e. with effect from 05/01/2024.

In view of the above, the matter of extension of term of engagement of 04 technical manpower hired from NICS I for another 12 months for OARS project is placed before TEC for discussion and appropriate decision.

1. For previous year w.e.f 01/04/2024, TEC had considered the proposal of F&S for extension of **05(five) nos** of manpower(Project Manager Tier-II-01, System AdminTier-II-02,Technical Manager-01 and Developer-01)
2. Now, F&S has submitted the proposal extension of engagement of **06(Six)** nos of manpowers through M/s NICS I for e-PDS/NFS/Fest project. The Details are as under:

FS & CA Department distribute the food grains through ePDS system with aadhar authentication of beneficiaries through finger or IRIS. The existing manpower deployed in NIC-Delhi & NIC-Hyderabad is looking after the development/maintenance of NFS/eFeast/ePOS system and day to day issue faced by Department functionaries while maintaining NFS services and FPS dealer in distribution of the food grain through ePOS. The deployed manpower is also looking after the activities related to DR management and VMs management (currently consisting of 23VMs) like VAs (every 3 months), Security Audit, SSL integration, Load Balancing, replication of data etc. Further the regular weekly/monthly activities like pushing of RCMS, SCMS data on Annavitran portal & IMPDS portal of Gol, monthly allocation of food grains is also looked after by the engaged manpower.

For smooth functioning and development/maintenance of module/APIs of ePDS system, RCMS,SCMS data sharing between State module (NFS/ePOS) and Center module (IMPDS) and **for maintaining the regular activities in terms of infrastructure, software, DR management, NIC- Delhi is required 05 Technical Manpower and NIC-Hyderabad is required 01 Technical manpower from M/s NICSI empanelled agencies for a period of 2 year w.e.f. 01.04 2024**

In view of above, the proposal of F&S Department for extension of engagement of **06 manpower from M/s NICSI empanelled agencies for a period of 2 year w.e.f. 01.04 2024** is placed before TEC for discussion and appropriate decision.

In this regard, following are submitted:

1. Earlier, the PGC had submitted the proposal for development & implementation of e-Court System through NIC and same has been discussed in TEC dated 21.12.2023. TEC has observed that in the proposal NIC has quoted the very high cost. Accordingly, it was

decided requirement of PGC should be reassessed by NIC in consultation with PGC and fresh proposal may be submitted by NIC to PGC for implementing as application similar to revenue e-Courts(Ref 138/C).

2. In this regard, PGC has sent a letter to NIC to reassessment the requirement(Ref. 144/C of attached file).
3. Now, PGC has proposed for online hearing system through Googlemeet /Webex as well as NIC VC(Video Conferencing) and informed that security of Data is the responsibility of service provider.
4. Proposal of PGC for requisite Logistic/electronic items with approximate cost is available at 39/N of attached file).

Subject: - Hiring services of consultants from NICS I for analyzing the existing infrastructure, technology (Hardware, Software etc) being used in existing CATS control room and preparation of draft RFP for selection of System Integrator for establishment /upgradation of the CATS control room.

The proposal of Department of Health & Family Welfare (H&FW), for approval of hiring of consultant for establishment and up-gradation of CATS room and for providing project management and technical support 24x7 to run the CATS control rooms, has been received with the recommendations of Secretary (H&FW).

Department has submitted the following: -

Centralized Accident and Trauma Services (CATS) has been providing free ambulance Services 24x7 basis since 1991 with the fleet of well-equipped ambulance through "102" toll free number.

Presently, CATS is operating total 380 ambulances (240 CATS owned+140 hired ambulances) through existing CATS control room.

Since calls receiving in Control Rooms are increasing gradually, therefore, CATS is intending to increase its existing fleet of 380 ambulance upto 600 ambulances as per requirement. And for this, the existing CATS Control Room is required to be upgraded/re-established alongwith back up control room to integrate 600 ambulances to cope up with the emergency situation arises in future like COVID-19 etc.

In this regard, Department sought to provide the following consultants to be engaged through NICS I in accordance with Circular vide dated 09.10.2015 issued by AR Department in prospect of the cabinet decision No. 2224 for execution of the same:

3. As per the AR Circular issued vide No. F.14/03/2015/AR/254-315 dated 09.10.2015, IT Consultants may be hired as per NICS I empanelment however, the in-principle approval of concerned minister is required even after the Technical Clearance of the IT Department.
4. Department will include the SLAs as per the T&C specified by NICS I.
5. Therefore, technical clearance of TEC is required in regard of the proposal in prospect of technical consultants submitted by H&FW Department.

So, in view of above if agree, proposal is placed before TEC for discussion on giving technical clearance in reference of the hiring of only 05 Numbers of Consultants through NICS I.
